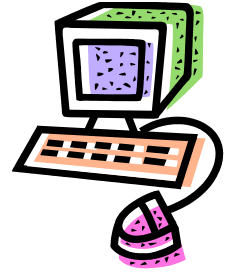


Interactive Math Websites And Apps For Kids *PreK- Grade 2*

- [Line ‘em Up](#) - Focus: sequencing numbers on a number line. (iOS*: there is an app for Android called Line ‘em Up, but it is a 2-player strategy game for older students)
- [Big Number Trace](#) - Focus: tracing numbers 0-50 (iOS)
- [Quick Images](#) - Focus: identifying images within a certain amount of time (iOS)
- [123 Ninja](#) - Focus: identifying and crossing out the correct number (iOS)
- [Dominoes Easy Match](#) - Focus: matching numerals to dot images/dominoes (iOS)
- [Splash Math](#) - This has grade-level specific apps to select from (iOS, Google Play, Android)
